## ***Subject: Inordinate delay in release of promotion and transfer in the CNS discipline***

Please refer to our letters No. CNSOG/CHQ/AND/2011/ dated 15<sup>th</sup> April 2011 Subject- "Disgruntled CNS executives" and our letter No. CNSOG/CHQ/PROMOTION/2010/ dated 14<sup>th</sup> March 2011 Subject- "Proposal for combined merged seniority in the CNS discipline".

Even after several requests, your office has not been taking cognizance of the vital issues that have been brought to your notice time and again.

The release of promotions in the CNS discipline is being inordinately delayed on the pretext of the nonviable proposal against the interest of aviation safety in connection with combined/ merged seniority in the CNS discipline. Your office, as well as the CNS and HR personnel is very much aware that there is going to be lot of dissatisfaction amongst the CNS executives because this proposal has no meaningful purpose except to satisfy few in their personal interests. **We have strong resentment and objection in the way it is being handled. This professional body having more than 700 dedicated CNS engineers and technical professional are not being taken into confidence for expressing their views.**

AAI management may continue to have discussions, meeting, presentations on this nonviable proposal of combined seniority in the CNS discipline. However Sir, you are responsible in depriving/ stopping eligible executives in queue due for promotions on the pretext of combined seniority in the CNS. It is once again requested that promotions be released immediately on the existing Policy.


